Who is this man that even the wind and waves obey him? Mark 4:41 In our Gospel lesson this morning, as he heals the Synagogue Leader's daughter and a woman with a hemorrhage, we see that Jesus love is not excluded from anyone who dares to put their faith in him. "Do not fear, only believe" he instructs Jairus when it seems that all hope is lost.
