JESUS. THE GIVER WHO JUST KEEPS ON GIVING

Even the disciples, Jesus' closest friends knew what it was to be overcome by doubt and fear. But huddled away in a hidden room, Jesus comes among them and gives them his peace.

Thomas wasn't in the room with them all the first time he came and refused to believe until he could see for himself. So what did Jesus do? He gave him the gift of peace as well.
