## THE GREATEST COMMANDMENT

JESUS REPLIED: "LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND." THIS IS THE GREATEST COMMANDMENT. AND THE SECOND IS LIKE IT: "LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF." MATTHEW 22:37-39

With the help of the Herodians, the Pharisees are at it again. This time they hope to trap Jesus out with a clever question about paying tax to Caesar and a question about which is the greatest commandment. Jesus is quick to spot their hypocrisy and as he always does he turns their question on it's head and answers;

*"Give to the emperor the things that are the emperor's, and to God the things that are God's." Mark 12:17)*

It may be the Emperor's image on the coins but as children of God we are the bearers of an even greater image, one that is best described in the answer to the question about which commandment Jesus thinks is the greatest. Jesus answer on this All Saints day is a reminder of how it is that we are called to live as his disciples
