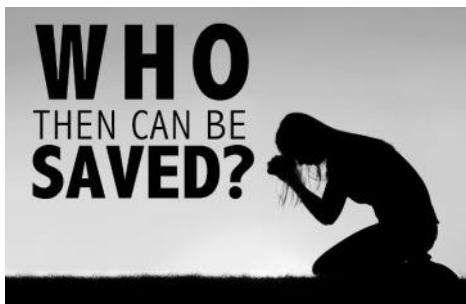

Jesus said again, “Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God.” Mark 10:25

In response the disciples ask, “Who then can be saved?”

As is often the case, the answer has already been given them. Only a few verses earlier Jesus told them, “Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it.” Mark 10:15

“Who then can be saved?” The answer is those who come to Jesus with the faith of a child. The thing about little children is that they are entirely dependent upon their parents for all their needs. As adults we can all too easily become dependent upon our own abilities and all that we have achieved and accumulated for ourselves. What Jesus asks of the rich young man and of us is our willingness to let go of our trust in our own self reliance and trust in him for all of our needs instead. “Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it.” Mark 10:15
